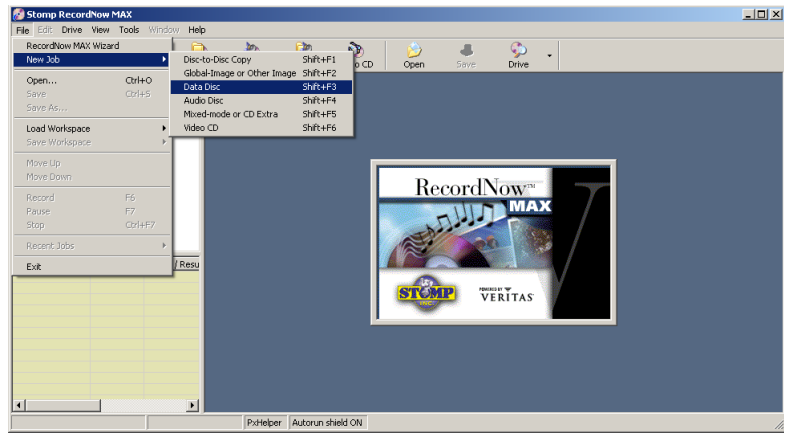
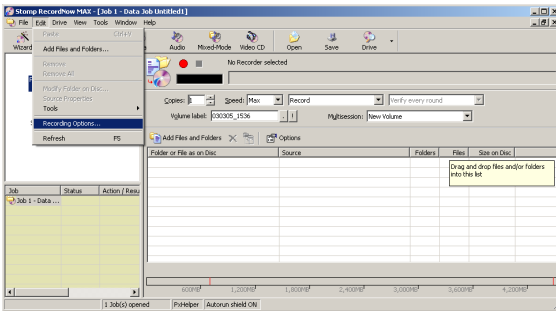


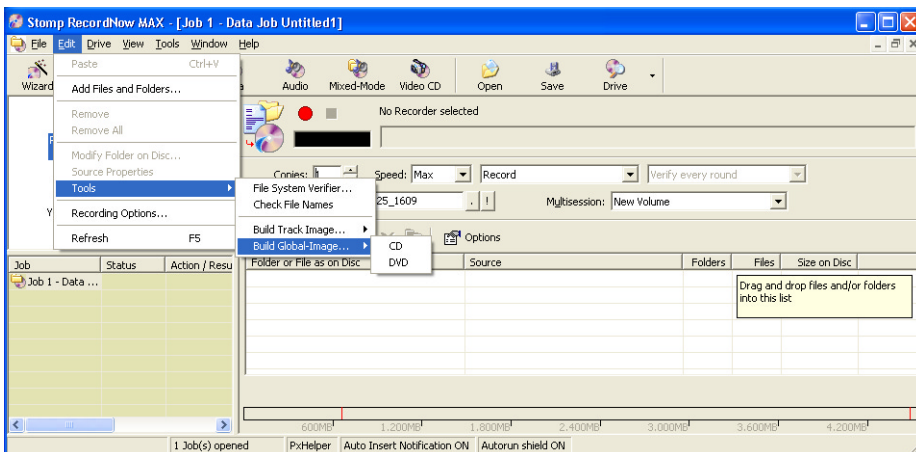
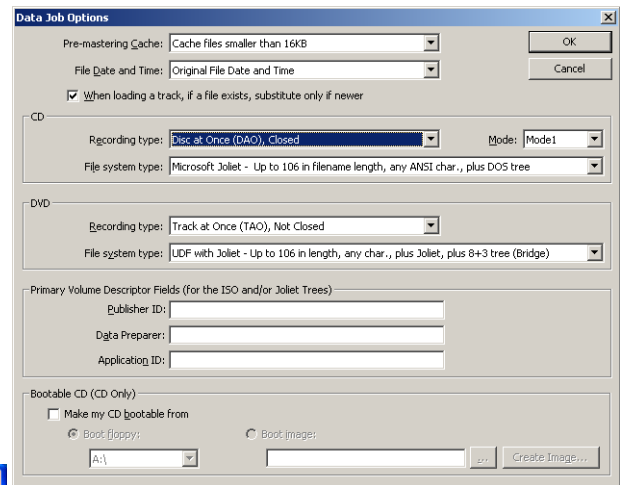
Create a new DATA cd, see your Instruction Manual for more information on setting up a new CD job.



From the Edit menu, Select recording options.



In the options window, choose Mode 1 in the mode drop box, this will create a CD that is more compatible with some players than a Mode 2 XA CD. If the option is grayed out, Mode 2 XA is required to produce your CD, in that case use Mode 2 XA. Also choose Disc at once (DAO), Closed for your recording type, unless you are creating a multi-session cd.



Next, choose Tools, then Build Global Image - CD/DVD from the EDIT menu. This will allow you to save your cd as an image file.

Select a name for your file and a location the interface that appears. Be sure to choose a location and a name that are easy to identify.

After Creating the image file, choose New Job - Global Image or Other Image from the FILE menu. From the EDIT menu, choose Add File and select the image file you created. Write a cd and test it. If it is ok, send us the image and we will be able to reproduce your cd exactly.
